

Applications for research grants from Märta Lundqvist's Foundation for the year 2021/2022

The purpose and goals of the foundation

The overriding aim is to promote research of the human brain at Swedish universities. In particular, patient related and clinically focused research will be given priority. The foundation also aims to stimulate younger researchers.

The research program must contain clear goals so that the results of the funds received can be evaluated. The year 2021/2022, the total funds that will be distributed amounts to SEK 2 090 000.

The Application

Who can apply for grants?

The announcement is addressed to scientists at any Swedish University with a doctoral degree (proof shall be submitted as an appendix to the application) within the timeframe of five years, ie after January 1 2017. Settlement of time can be made for parental leave and time for any AT service.

The project application

The application can be written either in Swedish or in English shall include i.a. information on project managers, fund managers and the amount of grants applied for, as well as the following mandatory appendices:

- Project description (research program)
- Merit list
- Budget

Project description

The project description shall not include more than a **maximum of 5 A4 pages** excluding references (12 point text size). The project description is sent together with the other appendices in a pdf file jointly attached to the application.

Content of the project description:

- Project titel
- Summary of the project (maximum 250 words)
- Purpose, hypothesis and issue
- A work plan
- Relevance
- Results achieved up to the present (if any)
- Expected results in relation to the project objectives
- Expected timeframe for how long the project will last
- The scientific and practical significance of the project

Schedule

Announcement of the program runs from October 2021 with the last date for submission of the application being January 13, at. 24.00, 2022. The evaluation work is ongoing in the spring of 2022 and a decision is expected in April.

Other information

Payment of a grant that is granted an applicant is made to the respective higher education institution. Both scientific results and financial accounting for how the funds have been used should be submitted to the Foundation no later than 2 years after the date of payment of the grant.
