Extract from UFV 2022/728 chapter 3 - “The rules on admission to doctoral studies are set out in Chapter 7, Sections 34–41 of the Higher Education Ordinance. The University Board has adopted regulations for applications, entry requirements, selection and admission in the Admission and Grading Regulations for Doctoral Studies at Uppsala University (UFV 2022/729). It is possible to admit doctoral students to a later part of a doctoral programme and in so doing for a shorter effective period of study than 24 months for a licentiate degree and 48 months for a doctoral degree”. Instructions for the department

The admission aims at: Application and admission to third-cycle education refers to one of the alternatives doctoral degree (four years of full-time studies) and licentiate degree (two years of full-time studies). If a person has previously been admitted to third-cycle education aimed at a licentiate degree or has completed a licentiate degree at another higher education institution, the doctoral degree, later part (two years of full-time studies) is stated.

Intended prefix in degree title: To be filled in when alternative degree titles exist within the faculty. This applies to the Faculty of Theology (theology or philosophy), the Faculty of Social Sciences (philosophy or economy) and the Faculty of Science and Technology (philosophy or technology).

The individual study plan must be attached when the decision is sent to the Office for Humanities and Social Sciences.
