In this study a phylogenomic analysis of <i>F. tularensis</i> was performed, constructing phylogenetic trees for 210 <i>F. tularensis</i> genes that had homologues in each of 15 other <math>\gamma</math>-proteobacteria and <i>Bacillus anthracis</i> Ames.
